Collective Media 3
A Juried Exhibition for High School Students
Hosted by Longue Vue House and Gardens

Longue Vue House and Gardens will host its annual juried exhibition for high school students from the Greater New Orleans area as part of the Collective Media student exhibition series. The goal of the Collective Media exhibition is to inspire youth through the visual arts and provide young artists a professional venue to showcase their works.

This exhibit will be held **May 10, 2018 through May 17, 2018** at the Longue Vue House and Gardens.

Eligibility

- Must be referred by a teacher or school representative
- Maximum 10 entries per school
- High school students in grades 9 through 12
- Students must reside in Orleans, Jefferson or St. Tammany parishes

Submission Requirements

- Artwork must be submitted by a high school teacher or representative
- High school teacher or representative may submit up to 10 pieces of art
- Pieces submitted can be created by students at anytime in their high school career
- Entries are not guaranteed acceptance
- Art does not need to be of any particular medium but all pieces must be able to be hung on the wall and in hanging condition

How to Submit Artwork

- Teachers and representatives who intend on having students participate must email Katherine Madere, Manager of Experiential Learning, by April 20, 2018.
- Artwork must be submitted by April 23, 2018 at 6 p.m. to kmadere@longuevue.com

Media

- All 2d media will be accepted
- Paintings, drawings, photography, computer-generated art and mixed media must meet the following criteria:
 - Must not exceed 16x20"
 - Must be ready to hang with any and all hardware required
 - Pastel and charcoal submissions must be sprayed and fixed
 - Sculptural work may be considered-email kmadere@longuevue.com



Jurors

A jury of Curatorial Staff, Members of the Board of Directors, and Artists-in-Residence from Longue Vue will select submissions.

Awards:

First-, second-, and third-place winners will be selected.

Sales

Longue Vue encourages all works to be for sale. Items sold at Longue Vue will receive a 15% commission. Not for sale (NFS) artwork must be marked as such and priced for insurance purposes (price need not be displayed).

Liability

Every precaution will be taken to assure protection of artwork. Longue Vue will not assume liability for hand delivered works left after pickup or shipping date of May 20, 2018.
